Olympic Event: 100-meter dash


Backyard Event: 100-foot dash

What to Do: Measure out 100 feet on your driveway, or in your backyard. Race solo for the first run of the day; ask an adult to keep time. Then compete in one-on-one elimination races, to determine the final winner of your household.

Olympic Event: Balance beam

Backyard Event: Chalk balance beam

What to Do: Draw two thick parallel lines with chalk. Make sure your "beam" is 20 centimeters wide and about 2 meters long. Create a variety of performance routines that could include a hop on one foot, balance a book on your head, or twirl a Hula-Hoop while you travel across the beam.



Olympic Event: Discus throw

Backyard Event : Frisbee (or pool tube) toss

What to Do: Hand out Frisbees, but what's even more fun—and actually more challenging—are inflatable pool tubes.Toss tubes one at a time, while an official (an adult) marks the distance. How far can the tubes go?
