Principal's Report

Welcome back to Semester 2 or Term 3 at Cambridge Gardens Public School! We are so excited to be at the start of the second half of 2023 and are excited to see our students and families return today! We hope you had an excellent two weeks over the school holiday period and that you were able to spend some quality and fun times with your children. Buckle in for some great learning and exciting activities in Term 3!

Staff News

There are a number of changes and additions to our staffing commencing this term.

Mr Hunter has commenced parental leave for the first six weeks of Term 3 and will return to work on Monday August 28. As you are aware there is an extreme shortage of teachers across the state and indeed across the nation. To ensure the continuity of learning and the wellbeing of our students our non-teaching Assistant Principals have offered to be the class

teachers for Class Holocene for two weeks each. In Weeks 1 and 2, Class Holocene will be led by Mrs Casey Hetherington with Mr Shanan Wood covering the class on Tuesdays when Mrs Hetherington is on leave. In Weeks 3 and 4, Mr Shanan Wood will teach the class with Mr Attard working with the class in Weeks 5 and 6. We all need to take the time to thank our committed Assistant Principals for putting the needs of the students of Class Holocene at the forefront of our actions. There will obviously be some disruption to the normal roles and responsibilities of these Assistant Principals and we thank you for your understanding with this. We are also very excited to have Mrs Alexis Hiser-Smith step forward to take on the leadership of our Stage three classes and teachers, taking on the responsibilities of Mr Hunter.

Our relieving Assistant Principal, Miss Alanna Vella will continue on leave for a further two weeks returning to work on Monday July 31. Miss Amy Lindsay will continue as the class teacher for Class Vikings throughout these weeks with Mrs Wendy Wright continuing on as the Stage 1 Assistant Principal throughout these two weeks.

Mrs Julie Cheetham will be on leave for weeks

1 to 3. Mrs Cheetham provides release from face to face teaching for many of our class teachers and the school has been fortunate to have secured casual teachers to cover Mrs Cheetham's teaching responsibilities throughout this time. Classes who will be affected by this will be Class Apollo, Class Aztec, Class Holocene, Class Renaissance, Class Triassic and Class Willandra.

Miss Alannah Antonelli will be on leave in Week 1. Ms Jaimee Pearson will be the class teacher for Class Apollo throughout this week.

Mrs Rose Antonelli will be on leave in Week 1. The school has secured casual staffing to ensure ongoing library lessons throughout Week 1. There will be no borrowing for Mrs Antonelli's classes in Week 1. Please don't return books this week. In regards to Mrs Antonelli's Assistant Principal leadership of Kindergarten throughout Week 1 please contact Mr Attard for any issues with Kindergarten.

The school has been unable to maintain temporary teachers to support our COVID 19 Intensive Learning Support Program. We have decided to operate in a different manner in Semester 2 with School Learning Support Officers conducting intensive intervention programs to small groups and individual students. We welcome two new School Learning Support Officers to Cambridge Gardens Public School this week. A big welcome to Ms Lisa Flanagan and to a former student of Cambridge Gardens Public School, Miss Allena Warren. These School Learning Support Officers may be working in your child's class or with your child in a small group in literacy or numeracy.

There has been a change of days for teachers on Class Aztec. For the rest of the year. Mrs Williams will be the class teacher on Mon, Tues and Thurs with Miss Emilia Wynn being the class teacher on Wednesdays and Fridays.

Great news for Class Willandra is that Mr Whiteside will continue on the class five days a week at this stage. We thank Mr Whiteside for juggling his university commitments in the interest of the students of Class Willandra.

Every term a different Assistant Principal is nominated to be my delegate in my absence. If you need to speak to me as the Principal on an important and urgent manner and I am not available or am absent please contact Mrs Hetherington throughout Term 3. Our fantastic office staff will also

direct you to Mrs Hetherington if I am unavailable. Always remember your point of contact is your child's teacher, the Assistant Principal in charge of your child's stage and then to myself. A quick reminder of our current Assistant Principals for supervision and support:

We are most excited to have so many parents submitting their enrolment enquiries and applications for next year. This has allowed the school to also assess those students' needs and we have already viewed some students in pre-school and applied for the support they may need for their transition to school to be successful. Please ensure if you have a child who will be attending Kindergarten with us in 2024 that you submit your application as soon as possible. If you have a neighbour or a friend as well with a student for 2024 can you please encourage them to complete this process as soon as possible. Our Assistant Principal for Kindergarten, Mrs Rose Antonelli is now scheduling parent and child interviews with her. Thanks for all your assistance in getting organised and helping to ensure everything is in place for your child and our school.

We have been overwhelmed with the high numbers of parents and friends visiting our classrooms during the Open Classroom opportunities. Whilst we understand Mums and Dads and Carers can't come to everything whilst

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD)

Every year, all schools in Australia participate in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD). The NCCD process requires schools to identify information already available in the school about supports provided to students with disability. These relate to legislative requirements under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* and the Disability Standards for Education 2005, in line with the *NCCD guidelines* (2019).

Information provided about students to the Australian Government for the NCCD includes:

Year of schooling

Category of disability: physical, cognitive, sensory or social/emotional

Level of adjustment provided: support provided within quality differentiated teaching practice, supplementary, substantial or extensive.

This information assists schools to:

Formally recognise the supports and adjustments provided to students with disability in schools

Consider how they can strengthen the support of students with disability in schools

Develop shared practices so that they can review their learning programs in order to improve educational outcomes for students with disability.

The NCCD provides state and federal governments with the information they need to plan more broadly for the support of students with disability.

The NCCD will have no direct impact on your child and your child will not be involved in any testing process. The school will provide data to the Australian Government in such a way that no individual student will be able to be identified – the privacy and confidentiality of all students is ensured. All information is protected by privacy laws that regulate the collection, storage and disclosure of personal information.

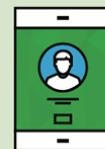
