




ENGRAVING DETAILS – MAX 17 CHARACTERS PER LINE

OPTION 2 - COMPLETE UP TO 6 LINES FROM AREAS 1 AND 2






INSTRUCTIONS FOR HAND DRAWN PAVERS


Follow these simple RULES to produce a quality engraved paver

- Use only a quality **BLACK** marker pen with a tip size **NO LESS THAN 2MM THICK**. Check with test line at the bottom of the page.
- We recommend an ARTLINE 70 or SHARPIE bullet point markers available at most stationery stores or supermarkets.
- DO NOT USE BALL POINT PENS, PENCILS, CRAYONS OR COLOURED MARKERS.
- If you are drawing over a pencil sketch, ensure that all pencil marks have been erased.
- Keep drawing and text large and simple. Do not use fine details, as they will not appear on the finished
