Special Note:

Canteen: There will be limited hot food sold at the carnival. Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch. A selection of chips, lollies, ice blocks and drinks will be available for purchase on the day. The canteen advises that they now have EFTPOS.

Events: All track events on the day are timed heats. Finals will only be held for 100m at 1.30pm on the day (approx.). Competitors for the District Athletics Carnival are determined by race times at the conclusion of age races.

1500m and Discus Events: We will be holding the discus and 1500m events of the Athletics Carnival at **8:15am** on **Wednesday 14th July 2021**, at Parker Street Reserve. Please note that the starting time for these events is prior to the official starting time of the **Athletics Carnival**. All students turning 8 years or older this year are able to compete in the discus event, however we encourage that your child be experienced with throwing a discus if they choose to compete. Mrs Nelson and Mr Hunter will be running the discus event. If you would like your child to compete in the discus event you will have to bring your child to Parker Street Reserve and meet Mrs Nelson and Mr Hunter on the track for an **8:15am** start. Upon completion of these events your child may stay and wait at the venue until the official start of the carnival but will need to be supervised by a parent/caregiver whilst waiting.

High Jump: Any student who would like to nominate for the High Jump event, will need to provide evidence from their Little Athletics Club of their best height. This distance will then be sent through with all the other nominations after the school athletics carnival.

Reminder: This Athletics Carnival is organised by CGPS, therefore all regulations, which apply to school premises as outlined by the Department of Education will be upheld.

Early Departures: Should you intend to take your child home by private transport, please sign your child out with the supervising teacher.

Special Note regarding COVID-19 safety regulations and requirements:

The current COVID-19 safety regulations and requirements of the Department of Education are listed below.

- Families/spectators must practise social distancing of at least 1.5 metres at all times during the carnival. To help facilitate this we ask that once you have chosen a seating position, to please remain in that spot throughout the carnival.
- Families/spectators must observe events from their chosen seating position or from outside the fencing of the track.
- Facemasks are not mandatory, but spectators may choose to wear them.
