We would like to keep you informed and give you an update with some procedures and events that are happening in Week 2 & 3.

Morning and Afternoon Procedures

Our morning and afternoon procedures will continue as they have until Friday 12th of February. Students will continue to enter through the front gate from 8:40am and parents of K-2 students may enter the school and drop off their children at the "drop off zone" if necessary. In the afternoon, Stage 3 students with their siblings will exit from the Driveway Gate at 3:00pm while Stage 2 students will exit from the same gate (Driveway Gate) at 3:10pm. Stage 1 students will continue to exit from the carpark gate at 3:10pm. We appreciate your support with these procedures.

Class Structures

Our class structures will continue as they have been as we are still confirming student enrolments. As you would be aware we have had a considerable drop in enrolment numbers due to the commencement of Jordan Springs in Term 3 last year. Once our Kindergarten cohort have commenced and school numbers are more accurate, we will communicate the set class structures for 2021.

Stage 3 Safer Internet Day Webinar
