We would like to extend an invitation to our parents to come along and view our Easter Hat Parade on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April.

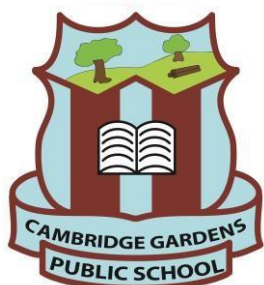
With the easing of some restrictions, we are looking forward to having parents able to come along and line the route of the student parade. The parade will begin at 10am.

If you can attend, we ask that parents enter the school through the back gate and bring a folding chair to sit comfortably during the parade, as no seating will be provided. All visitors must use the QR code and sign an External Visitor's Form upon arrival as a requirement for attending this event. An External Visitor's Form has been attached to this email so you can print and sign it before you arrive at the event. All parents are asked to attend only if they are COVID symptom free and social distancing must be maintained between adults from different households. We ask parents to sit with household members only and sit at least 1.5 metres from other guests. Staff members will be assisting parents with seating arrangements from 9.45am. Parents will be seated on the grassed area. Students will sit with their classes in Area 1 and 4.

Students will design and make their Easter hat at home to wear on Thursday the 1<sup>st</sup> April. Each class will participate in a class vote for their favourite Easter hat and an award and small Easter gift will be awarded. All Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 classes will be walking around in a loop of the school to show both parents and students their hat designs. Students in Years 3-6 will be invited to also participate in the walk around the school showcasing their creations.

Thank you for your ongoing support and understanding as we seek to keep our whole community safe throughout these changing conditions. We look forward to seeing our wonderful students wearing their creative Easter hat designs on the day and we wish our students and community a safe and wonderful break.
