Each class will participate in a 45 minute workshop run by Penrith City Council Environment educators, supervised by their classroom teacher. There is no cost for this incursion, all workshops are provided free by Penrith City Council.

The Enviromentors 'Into the Bin' incursion accompanies our school's participation in this year's Clean Up Australia Day and supports student learning of the Science and Technology syllabus for the following outcomes:

**Science and Technology ST2-7MW-T** Investigates the suitability of natural and processed materials for a range of purposes

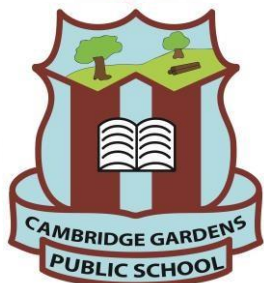
**Science and Technology ST3-7MW-T** Explains how the properties of materials determines their use for a range of purposes

The aim of each workshop is to raise awareness of the consequences of a range of waste management actions as well as the implications of littering. Students will investigate the benefits of avoiding waste, reusing and recycling, with an emphasis on local content. This will develop skills and attitudes that facilitate the adoption of waste minimizing actions and empowerment to encourage others to do so also.
