Dear Parents and Carers

As advised earlier, our school will have limited staff and will be providing minimal supervision, tomorrow, Wednesday March 9.

Many of our staff will still be isolated by floodwaters and will be unable to be onsite tomorrow.

Minimal supervision means that students who attend school, will be supervised by an available teacher in an appropriate group. It is highly likely that students will not be with their own class teacher or in their own class group. It is anticipated that student numbers will be low tomorrow.

As student numbers are expected to be low tomorrow, all students will be dismissed at 3.10pm through GATE A. Older students will collect younger siblings prior to 3.10pm.

Our canteen will be closed tomorrow.

Camp Australia and Rainbow Cottage will be operating tomorrow.

If students are at home tomorrow, they can complete the second day in the digital learning package and bring any completed work into their class teacher on Thursday.
