Dear Parents,

Welcome back!

I hope you have enjoyed an amazing Christmas, New Year and holidays. Every child I have spoken to has had wonderful stories of overseas trips, heading to Tasmania, NSW beaches, those wonderful Worlds as well as great local fun!

It has been an extremely difficult commencement of the year for our school with uncertainty around the number of classes we can form, a number of last minute staff acquisitions, as well as electrical issues making half our classrooms unusable. Many decisions regarding staffing, classes and classrooms were still being made throughout Monday and Tuesday as approvals were gained. This has made it impossible to provide accurate and early information. Our school has not been in this situation for a number of years. That being said, we had a great day! As always I marvel at our staff for their flexibility. Well done! We are expecting our electricity to be restored in the next day or two. Some classes will be working in different locations throughout the week.

All students yesterday went into their previous classes. This allowed us to ascertain the number of children we have, in order to form classes. Our numbers have been hovering between 397 and 404 which is the difference between 15 and 16 classes. Once we had an understanding of our absence level, we decided to form 16 classes and moved children into those classes. You will have received today an email with a letter from your child's teacher at this stage as well your child being given this in a hard copy to bring home. Please note, we are still very unsure of if we will need to move to 15 classes. This cannot be finalized until after all Kindergarten students commence full enrolment which is not till next Monday, February 6. We will keep you updated.

This year our class names are based on History. It will be exciting to learn about the origins of the class names throughout the year. This year as a school community our theme will be around the question, Are you being kind? We will be reflecting on this with students, staff and parents.
