Education and Awareness - Student Information Session

Dear Parents/Carers

The Online Guardians are an eSafety accredited organisation who are experts in the field of social networks and adolescent development. They have presented to over 300,000 students in the past decade and have a wealth of hands-on experience working within schools and with young people in the ever-changing digital world.

The Online Guardians provide a service that incorporates safety, awareness, and age appropriate educational content to primary school students within the school setting. Teen Culture: TikTok, Snapchat, influencers, secrecy, search history

Safety Online: Online offenders, parental controls, supervision, Wi-Fi, early education.

Culture and Trends: Live streaming, ghost mode and artificial intelligence.

Strategies: Tools, ideologies, recommendations – Parent Support Network.

Our core learning principles of Safety, Balance and Respect remain the focus of our education.

Our seminars will identify school culture, trends and safety issues relevant to student online experiences whilst providing guidance and direction on critical age-appropriate topics. We provide a 'debrief' with students following our presentation to answer individual questions and assist with a variety of digital enquiries.
